How the Government Shutdown could Impact Travel

- **Air Travel / Security / Air Traffic:** TSA agents and air traffic controllers are classified as "Essential". They are required to continue working. However, though essential, morale, absenteeism and staffing gaps can cause slower operations. Past shutdowns saw increased no-shows or sick calls among TSA or air traffic personnel, which can compound delays.
- **Passport & Visa Services:** There is a risk that documents could be delayed during the shutdown
- **Leave more buffer time when traveling.** Expect longer lines at security checkpoints and possible delays in flight schedules.
- **Flights may be delayed or changed in response to constraints in airspace management or staffing.**
