FAA to Reduce Airspace Capacity by 10% Beginning November 7

The FAA has announced it will temporarily reduce flight capacity by 10% in 40 major U.S. markets starting Friday, November 7, due to increased reports of air traffic controller fatigue during the ongoing federal government shutdown.

This change may result in fewer flights, longer delays, and potential cancellations, particularly during peak travel times (8–10 a.m. and 4–6 p.m.).

Airlines are expected to prioritize hub-to-hub and international routes, while some domestic and regional flights may be reduced. The FAA will adjust capacity levels once conditions stabilize.
